The Waterfall Trail

The homeowner was looking to remodel his 25year old master bath, longing for a sleek, modern space with a two-person shower and all the latest water features. In the new layout, the door between the bathroom and the main hallway was closed off, creating space for a room shower. The shower features a handheld showerhead, body sprays, main shower head as well as a rain showerhead. The design comfortably accommodates a double vanity as well as an elegant locker-style storage cabinetry on the opposite wall. The designer extended the bench in the shower past the glass and all the way to the storage unit. The unique double-sided bench, installed with a waterfall edge, appears to float. The vanity and storage cabinet have a rich dark knotty oak finish and bright chrome legs that add contrast. The room is entirely lit with LED lighting. The glass tile in the shower mimics a waterfall, embracing a soothing cascade effect.
